within the Pearl of Great Prices are three books: the book of Moses, the book of Abraham and the writings of Joseph Smith. The book of Moses came into existance in June, 1830, only two months after the organization of the church as a revelation to the prophet. It is a kind of introduction to the book of Genesis; it tells how mosess came to Know the story of thee creation, and the relation of man to God. A/ little later in the same month, extracts from the prophecy of Enoch mentioned by Jude in the Old Testament were revealed to Joseph smith and added to the book of Moses/

Because of the uniqueness of the book of
Abraham shistory, I would like to leave it
untill last and tell you first a little about
the last book of the Pearl of Great Price, the
writings of Joseph Smith. The first section/99/
is an extract from a translation of the 24th
chapt. of Matthew and gives in much more precise

language than the bible an insight on the last days and the saviours second coming. The second section contains extracts from the history of Joseph Smith. It tells of his first visions and revelations, of his obtaining the plates of gold, and also the account of his baptism and Ordination. The thrid section contains the Articles of Faith.

Now to go back to the second book. The Book of Abraham. Its seems that in the year of 1828 a French explorer named Antonio Sebolo. obtained permission from Mehemet Ali, the Viceroy of Egypt to explore for antiquities where stood formerly the acient City of Thebes. Here he entered some catacombs and carried away eleven mummies found in a perfect state of preservation. On his way to Paris, however, M. Sebolo died; therefore, the mummies were directed to a nephew named Chandler. Mr Chandler lived in Philidephia, Pa. Though it was supposed his home was in Ireland After a devious course, the mummies finally came to New York, addressed to Micheal Chandler. There the caskets were first opened and examined. In conection with two of the bodies was found two rolls of Papyrus beautifully written with black, and small part red, ink or paint.

A stranger standing near at the time recommended to Mr. Chandler that he seek out the Mormon Prophet Joseph Smith, as probably the only man who could give a correct traslation of the manuscripts. However, Mr. Chandler began to exibit the mummies in the larger cities of the United States where he secured certificates from learned men that the mummies and papyrus were geniume. At last he came to the City of Kirtland where he immediately sought out the Prophet and presented him with copies of the Egyptian characters to translate. The prophet gave him the interpretation and recieved the follow ing certifiacte from Mr. Chandler.

[&]quot;This is to make known to all wgo may be a

desirios, concerning the knowledge of Mr. Joseph Smith Jr, in deciphering the ancient Egyptian heiroglyphic characters in my possesion, which I have in many eminent cities, showed to the most learned; and, from thw information that I could exever learn, or meet with, I find that Mr. Joseph Smith Jr.: to correspond in the most minute matters Michael H. Chandler, Traveling with and Proprietor of Egyptian Mummies.

Soon after recieving this certificate some of the Saints in Kirtland purchased from Mr. Chandler the mummies and Papyrus. There upon the prophet began to translate the Hieroglyphics and to his joy found that one of the rolls contains the writtings of Abraham, where as the other contains writtings of Joseph , who was sold into Egypt. The first of these the Prophet translated in part. It recounts the trails of Abraham in the Idolatrous home of his father's and his miraculous deliverance. It tells also of the creation of the world and of the spirits before, and reveals the system of

Astronomy understood by the ancient Patrirach.

It appears that the Papyrus roll containing the writtings of Joseph was never translated.

After the prophets death the mummies and Papyrus were sold and after changing hands eventually were exibited in a Chisago museum, when the great fire swept Chicago in 1870, the museum was destroyed; and with it, presumbbly the mummies and the scared records of old.

I hope that through my telling somewhat of the contents of the Pearl of Great Price and the history behind it that a desire has been created in you to read the sacred record, and I do it in the name of Jesus Christ
