Mt Vernon. When they got to Cedar Rapids he
bought a house on 2nd Ave & pd cash.
for it became 1st dr on Mule St. ^{drain} Railway,
on H Avenue - He & Florence went in & 9
house sold & moved. when got to La Fayette -
Clare just recently torn down.

When Howard was 2 yrs old Henry C Jr
moved to Pocatello, Idaho. Got a job
as a fireman ^{short line} R.P. ^{when} 1/2 yrs of age
Henry C ~~moved~~ ^{transferred} to Ogden & worked on
Cache Valley line from Ogden to Logan,
worked for 6 yrs & then went as a
brakeman on So Pacific R.R. worked
there for 7 yrs & then quit & started a
transfer business in Ogden. When he
came to Ogden he paid cash for his
home at 2783 Pacific Avenue.

233 1/2 5th st. transfer wagon (2 horse)
& one horse express wagon. Sold Hay, grain,
kindling wood, coal. Got coal from Vd, sack it
up. In those days people used coal to
cook with & heat apt bldg. Has to carry
coal 2 or 3 stories high in those apts.
100 lbs of coal on your back at a time.
