1958

Monday 17 - Went in to cover the

March 31, 1958

at 12 o'clock PM my membranes
ruptured and at 2 o'clock I
started in labor. I tried to
sleep but the contractions kept
me awake so I went into the
b.R. with my pillows and
blanket so I could time contractions
and let Tracy get a little sleep.
at 6:30 I called the Dr. and
told him and he said I had
better go to the hospital.

Tracy had a regulator coming
from General Motors and
was going to be tied up all
day. He left at 7:30 and
told the nurse to call him when
I went into the delivery room.
The pains kept up all day
but I didn't dilate. When
Tracy came at about 9 o'clock
that night I was still there.
The pains were quite hard
but very irregular. They had
been 2 quarts of water delivery
before me that day.
My past history is that
when I do dilate it's fast and
the baby is born shortly. In
the morning about 10 AM
Dr. ordered a shot but the
nurse prepared a delivery room
first so it would be ready.
It was used a bit
before I used it.

at 8 I sent Tracy home
I was disquid. The
pains were harder when they
