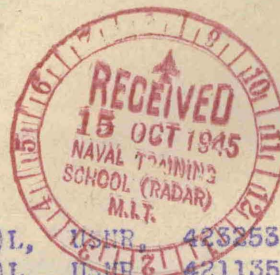

1. Report for embarkation to Pier 38 at 1400
2. ANY OFFICER MISSING HIS SHIP IS SUBJECT TO SEVERE DISCIPLINARY ACTION.
3. Contact your local address at 1000, 1400, and 1800 until reporting for embarkation. You will be notified by message of any change in these instructions.
4. Officers living in BOQ MUST check out of hotel on date of embarkation.
5. Tag all baggage and parcels with name only. Print in large letters.
  - (a) HOLD baggage will be showed below decks and not available during voyage. Use WHITE tag for HOLD baggage.
  - (b) Not more than ONE piece of hand baggage allowed in cabin. Use GREEN tag for CABIN baggage. No footlockers are allowed in cabin.
6. You may go to the pier ahead of time, but do not report to go aboard before time stated above (No. 1). BE PROMPT.
7. EVERY OFFICER MUST REPORT TO THE PORT DIRECTOR'S PASSENGER LOADING OFFICER at the gangway before embarking (No.1).
8. DO NOT GO ABOARD OR PLACE ANY GEAR ABOARD UNTIL INSTRUCTED TO DO SO BY THE PORT DIRECTOR'S PASSENGER LOADING OFFICER.
10. There will be no shore liberty after boarding.
