In Sept. of 1978 we made Charlotte move into an apt so as to be "on campus". She and Emma Jane Carlisle & two other girls rented an apartment at a complex on 9th East. Abt 2 wks after she moved in, the Bishopric called on them to "look them over" for prospective jobs & meet them. One of the counselors, Bryan Wight said he knew the minute he saw her she was "the one". Within a month they were engaged & they married in December. I told her of I'd known that it would happen so fast I'd have waited another semester to push her out of the nest.
