Sunday-Jan 25. Tracy has been ill since Christmas & can't seem to throw it off. He got the right after Christmas. We thought he was doing very well at throwing it off on his own, but it returned. He went to Dr. Wallace who gave him polymox. Tracy's reaction to this was worse than the flu. at least he thought it was a reaction to the polymox. He called his counselors (Tracy is Bishop since July 4th) and they gave him a blessing. Dr. Wallace then gave him a series of penicillin shots. It's been a strange 4 weeks. He has only had about 5 days when he felt he was getting better. Friday evening Dr. Wallace called in response to a call I had put in to him that day. I asked if gamma Globulin might give him ~~a shot~~ of some help in throwing off what the Dr. has diagnosed as still reaction from the flu.
