We are in the middle of winter here and it is cold. You are plenty warm there, I guess. Since I have been Relief Society President we have had four funerals. Here it is the custom that when a ward member dies the members of the Relief Society prepare a dinner for the relatives of the disceased. Usually we will have a couple of the districts of visiting teachers plan and make the assignments. While you are still quite a small branch you probably won't be called upon to do anything like that.

I have a wonderful group of about 100 ladies who always seem to be willing to ~~do~~ anything they can to help when anyone in the ward is sick or when there is a funeral. Brother Hall's health hasn't been too well since we have been home from his mission-- he just doesn't seem to have the stamina and strength he used to have. We hope this will improve as time goes on.

In Feb. my daughter Virginia will have our 30th grandchild. My youngest daughter, Nancy, expects her third child in August which will bring the total to 31. Of our seven, however, some of the families seem to be complete now, and so the increase in our descendants is slowing down considerably.

We hope and trust you are all well. Have any of your children married since we have left Zimbabwe?

By now you should have received my first order for christmas ornaments and the samples which show what I want. I will send another next week, and one more after that. Hope you get them all. The disadvantage of sending it strung out like this is that it will cost you \$12. to cash them, instead of just \$3. But I just didn;t dare send so much at one time, for fear it would get lost in the mail.
