Since I am now about to finish my mission is, on Nov 8 I would like to ask you if you can help me. I want to raise money to pay for my school tuition at Ricks College in U.S.A. I would like to send you some crochet dresses & some table cloths so that you can sell them for me & just keep the money until it can maybe take me for two years college.

Would you please try to talk to sisters in your ward to see if they can buy the things, things are tough here without education I think you know that very well. The govt can not give me a grant to study here but if I send you more of my things I think by the end of 1984 I will be able to make it without any problem. I would like to go to a church college because it will be easy for me to follow the rules for me.

I will be very grateful to hear what your idea would be but I would like to study there so please just try to find me some customers who can be able to pay for my education. I can't say much about our place I think you know everything. I have applied for a place at Ricks College & they have send me some forms but I can't return them to them because I don't have the funds.

We are doing fine out here plenty of converts & baptisms. All single missionaries have been removed from Zimbabwe except the couples straight from the M.T.C, U.S.A and they will start to be here by November 5. I am trying not to be a slave to the govt that is to work for them please try to help me by enquiring about my motive. Hope to hear from you soon so that I can start send in some stuff so that you can sell.
