Klinket Clan house -

made of Western red cedar - ^{Large trees} easy to work with -
50 people lived in ^{house, usually 2-3} related to chief.
Look house with them to salmon run
roof house posts & background roof ^{upright beams,}
were left.

In fall returned & put up again.

fire in spot in center of house - air hole above
^{for smoke to} escape.
stored under boards of elevated floor.

Sometimes long-house had 13 keels.

Slaves - captured from tribes living warfare -
another sign of wealth: sometimes given away or
sacrificed at Salatchu.

Klinkets & Haida's enemies early - made
slaves of roving neighbors - center upright -
at ^{point of} ground - roof uprights they had totem pole
face bull sealion - (one of crest symbols)

genealogy: h. into mother's clan - young
men sent to uncle when 12 or so for "training"
