Catch tranquility of water + Island.

Mornings a good time to take pictures.

Photography (art) should delight eye, heart, soul.

Get some meaning into your picture if possible.  
(movement of line or body)

He showed us the ice fields - (Recess of Ice)  
they are moving rivers, can't be crossed because

"Drama of light and dark" (value)

We missed the ride ~~up~~ Endicott arm during the lecture, but I understand we'll see a lot of that during this trip.

It's cloudy and overcast this morning. Dr. Gunn showed us the use of this "dimness" in photography. (Some of most spectacular <sup>shots</sup> ~~shots~~ taken when sun just ~~shows~~ appears through patchy layers of clouds.)
