Beliefs of Yukon territory.

Alaska was called
Seward's folly. Russian's thought Siberia
connected to America. In 1741 Spanish,
afraid of Russians, came up north to settle &
counteract the Russians.

Capt. Cook claimed Alaska for
England. (3 voyages into Pacific)
(7.2 ^{Seward's} million) Cook brought a lot of
souvenirs back to Britain - now in museums.

Cook impressed by ^{the} different cultures found in Alaska.
Russians in Aleutian enslaved Aleuts - forced
them to hunt for furs
near sea otter furs.

~~Seward's~~ built a church in Sitka.
more Russian influence there -
