really be moving mountains.

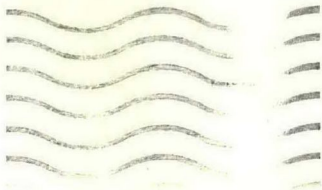
We taught the Girwood's
