

in Va. brought pressure for new lands
in Indian territory, even the success

ment on their lands.

The French & Indian war was
marked by the nations of the Indians
especially the Iroquois (6 nation) group
uniting - also there was cooperation
among Cherokee, Creek, & Mingo tribes
in the Ohio valley. Unfortunately, the
Indians chose the wrong side when ^(the French)
they did not remain neutral. Strong
Indian leadership left the Indian
tribes during this war in a much
stronger position.
