Appalachians for Indian & appointed  
2 Indian agents to manage Indian  
affairs -

This failed, too, as colonists &  
land agents succeeded in getting lines  
changed and "white squatters" ignored the  
proclamation.

Although the period from 1763  
to 1785 was marked by bloody  
conflict between white and Indian -  
the Indian succumbed to superior  
white numbers and warfare.

The Iroquois and Cherokee moved  
north, west, and south having either  
sold their lands or having lost them
