when the French Indian war ended and the English really seriously began to police her colonies, most colonies had colonial legislatures elected by the people and usually another house called the Governor's council which the members of which were appt. by Royal Governor often for "life".

In 1763 at the end of the years near the British debt was enormous, of an 8 million dollar budget (if I remember correctly) 5 million went for interest on the debt. England decided it was time that the colonies paid their share.

This led to a series of acts passed by Parliament, which the colonies resisted beginning with the sugar act and ending with the tea act which precipitated the Boston tea party and which prompted the English to pass the Coercive acts,
