In 1763 at the end of the 7 years war the British debt was enormous, of an 8 million dollar budget (I'd remember correctly) 5 million went for interest on the debt. England decided it was time that the colonies paid their share.

This led to a series of acts passed by Parliament, ~~which~~ the colonies resisted beginning with the sugar act and ending with the tea act which precipitated the Boston Tea party and which prompted the English to pass the Coercive acts,
