Anyway ~ I enjoy reading the Mallmanack. What I really do is skim. I'm most interested in ~~hearing~~ reading about my cousins.

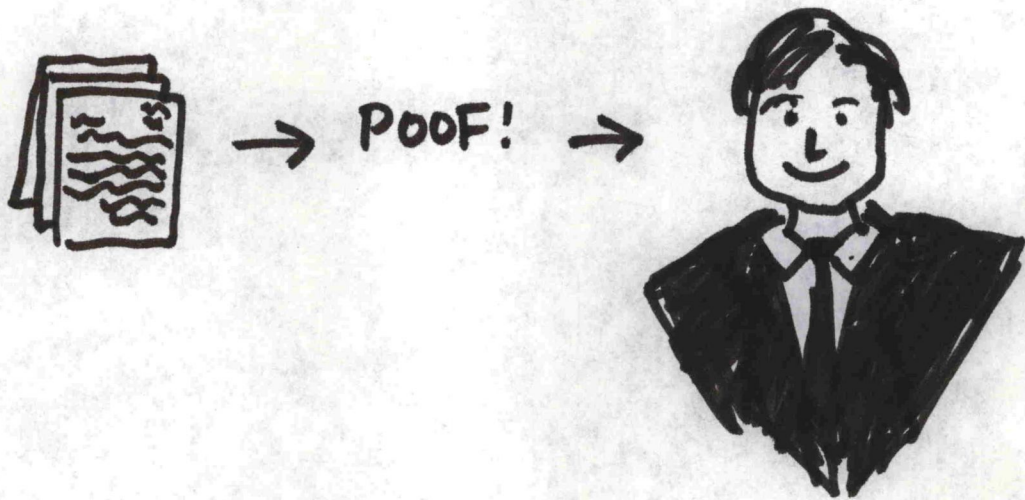
