AIRLINE FARES:

Plane ticket from Seattle to D.C. on Delta Airlines is $\$ 298 /$ person round trip. (Their fares went up $\$ 20$ dollars on Sunday.)
RESTRICTIONS: Travel must take place after noon on Monday or on Thursday. Tickets must be purchased at least 14 days in advance.
Tickets non refundable. Dates of travel cannot be changed.
Ticket prices can be changed at any time.
(check with airlines for possible other restrictions-buy tickets early as possible I recommend that families travel on Thursday the 30th of June so that they can enjoy the 4 th of July activities. If you leave Monday the 4 th of July after 12 noon you would not arrive in D.C. until about 8 pm. Sharlene would love to have visitors before or after the reunion. She lives 5 hours from Washington D.C.

If you want a direct flight you have to fly into Dulles(?sp.) which is 35 minutes from Virginia's house. If you want to fly into National (it's fun to fly over the city and see the monuments) you have to have connecting flights from Chicago or elsewhere.

Virginia invites family to stay longer than one week. She said if you're going to spend the money to come back and want to make a longer vacation out of it you can use her home as a base. She claims to have 2 kitchens and 7-8? bedrooms and plans to turn her home into motel for the month of July. The rooms are free but we'll all need to kick in and help with food preparations and costs.
