

Dear Mom & Dad,

Hyrum is thrilled with his birthday gift. He misses seeing his grandparents. When we are in the car for a long drive he begins to ask if we are going to Grandpa's house. He must remember the "long" drive from Delta to Grandpa's house. I took HYrum in for a physical and the Dr. says that although he is still on the low end of the scale he is progressing well. Bryan began training with Northwest Inspection Engineers on Tuesday. He trains for two months without pay. When he begins inspections on his own he will be paid on a commission basis.
