on Sunday anymore!

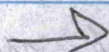
TIPPEE!

but could always use a couple more! ☺

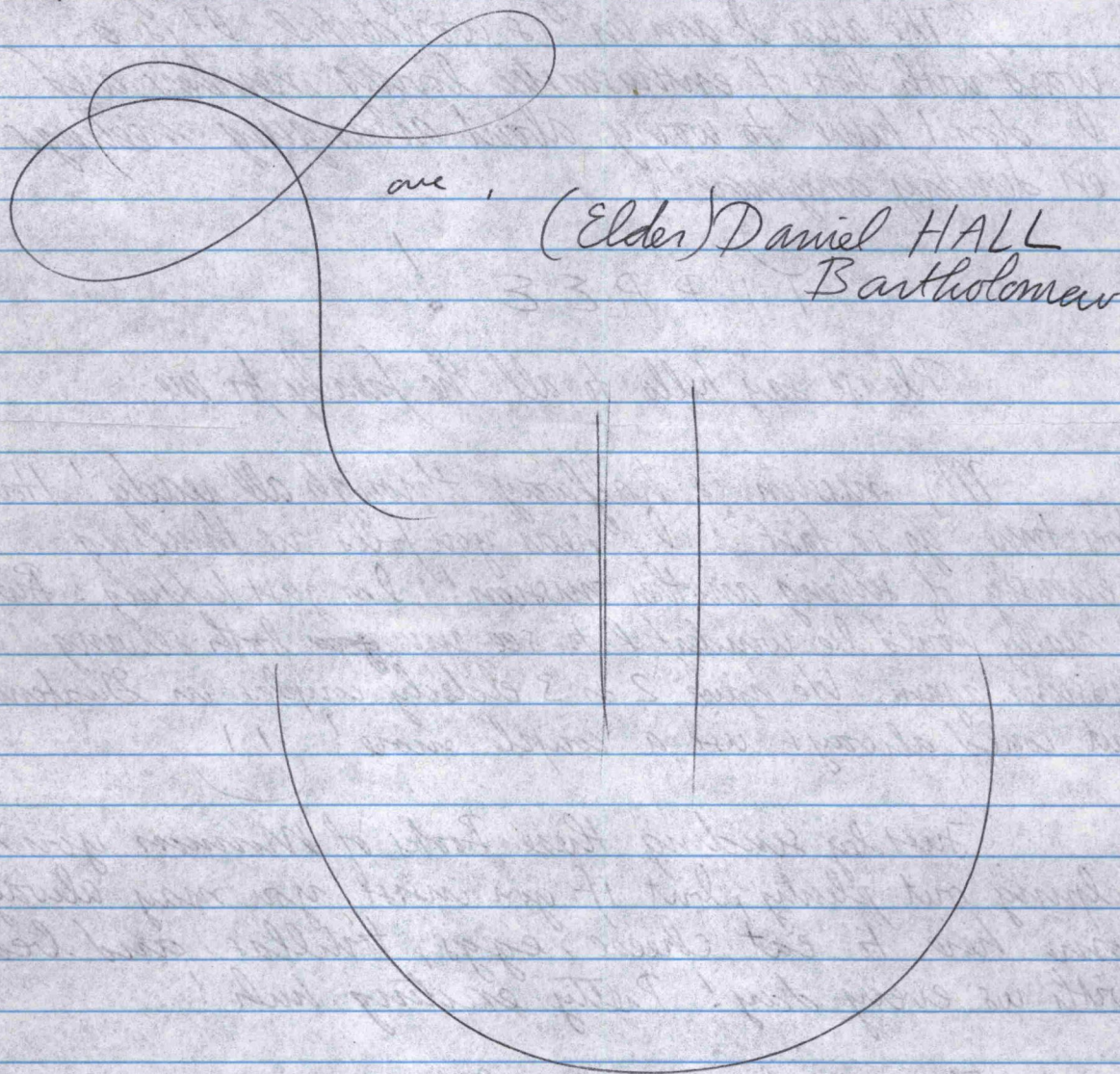
Just by sending these Books of Mormon you're
