March has been very hectic for us! Last Friday Barry got some estimates for home insulation. We decided to go with the company that did our church's insulation. They agreed to do it the following Tuesday, before Mom & Dad Wood flew into D.C. Well, they were supposed to finish Tuesday, but it took them half of Wednesday also. Well Tuesday night I was in an absolute panic. They drilled a total of 204 holes, 3" across in our plaster walls (on the inside of our house, as the exterior is brick) There was $\frac{1}{4}$ " of plaster dust covering everything. One of my counselors in the MIA called and said she'd like to come over Wed. morning and give me a hand. Well not only did she come, she brought two other willing bodies with her. Then Mom and Dad Hall will hopefully make it out for a visit prior to their Texas speaking assignment.

This time you shouldn't have to sleep downstairs. We've been hard at work trying to get the three upstairs bedrooms liveable. We even bought another double bed so you won't have to sleep on the "couch".

I've been up to my ears in YWMA work. The kids are trying to raise enough money to go to Florida during Spring Break (April 16-22). Last week we raised \$430.⁰⁰ at a garage sale. This Saturday we have a bake sale going on at the local Safeway and a pizza sale at the Church following conference (between 4 and 6 p.m.) We've raised about \$900.⁰⁰ already but that's only about half of what they'll need.

I got my seeds from Burpee and am anxious to get a garden in (well, I'm anxious for Barry to get a garden in.)

We received our tax assessment \$64,900!!! We bought the house 8 months ago for \$55,000 so Barry protested it. They came yesterday to look over the inside and reassess it.
