

BRYAN WEIGHT FAMILY LETTER, JUNE 1985

DEAR FAMILY,

TOMORROW WE ARE GOING TO MANTI TO ATTEND THE REDEDICATION OF THE MANTI TEMPLE. WE WERE MARRIED THERE AND HAVEN'T BEEN BACK SINCE OUR WEDDING DAY SO WE'RE LOOKING FORWARD TO GOING. DAVID, KAREN, AND FAMILY VISITED WITH US A COUPLE OF DAYS LAST WEEK. THEY SPENT SOME TIME AT THE SAND DUNES AND THEN CAME INTO DELTA. WE SO RARELY HAVE VISITORS AND IT WAS REALLY A TREAT TO HAVE THEM COME. DAVID AND KAREN CAME WITH BRYAN AND I TO THE CULTURAL COUNCIL'S RENAISSANCE DINNER AND FASHION SHOW.
