Charlotte and I had a most enjoyable stay in Utah during Thanksgiving. We saw everyone we had planned to and a few more. In addition to Charlotte's family, I have three sisters and a brother attending BYU. Two of these sisters and my little brother are married and struggling through school. My father was born and raised in Springville, where my grandmother still lives. My father being the oldest of eight, you can imagine all the local relatives.
