II. Winthrop Jordan, White over Black (1968)

A. Limited Early Evidence

1. 1619 first Africans arrive
2. 1640 first evidence of slavery and discrimination
3. 1660 first slave laws
4. 1705 first comprehensive slave code

III. Oscar Handlin, "The Origins of the Southern Slavery System" (1950)

A. Negroes were indentured servants until 1660 and a fluid system until then

1. stresses closeness of whites and blacks — shorter indenture
2. development of new economic factors lead to improvements for whites

*law for blacks
for white servants*

VI. Other Explanations

A. Edmund Morgan, American Slavery, American Freedom (1975)

1. rebellions led to preference for black laborer
2. in fact little preference for recently arrived blacks

B. Use of slaves led to a drop in the number of whites

1. problem with timing

C. Profitability of blacks versus whites

1. problem of lack of reproduction until 1720s

D. English Demographic Factors

1. slower growth in English population late 17th Century
2. growth of London--Christopher Wren's reconstruction
3. new colonial targets for immigration for whites

a. Pennsylvania: 8000 Englishmen went there 1681-85

4. end of Royal African Company slave trade monopoly, 1698

5. impact of these factors on Southern society

a. growing necessity for large amounts of capital to purchase slaves
