overseas fur trade begins, Hudson Bay started operation  
on opp. coast of mainland. Growth of Victoria & new  
Westmen.

radical effect on Indians who had already

2. 1876-1900. missionaries active. Reserves  
for Haida introduced. This period considered to  
be first directed phase in archipelago.

3. 1900-1940 - Commercial fishing starts,  
Commerce opened in area, agricultural colonization  
expanded somewhat, lumbering - and provision  
of social assistance.

4. 1940-70 - 2nd world War - ultimately felt in  
Islands. New Policy with respect to Indian population
