

by 1820 masks used only occasionally

carved items used in dancing ceremonies  
wooden carved boxes

by 1936 - evaporated (above)

Hunting hats.

(bent & painted wood) ~~soak~~ planed,  
soaked, and joined in back. Trimmings with  
paints, beads, Ivory.

Chugach & Koniag made hunting hats woven  
from roots.

neither the Aleuts nor Koniags usually wore  
hats for everyday use - but had elaborate  
headgear for ceremonial use.

Effigy monuments:

grave or memorial monument.

2 kinds 1) Pale monument with a human  
face integral with pole or an animal  
sculpture. 2) a board monument  
being with carved human faces or whole figures  
used to mark graves

Representative Painting

Peoples of W. Alaska used only geometric designs  
on Ivory, done by men

family property mark - men & women,  
elaborate ones on drums
