

Ernest Langford Sr.

Ernest F. Langford Sr., 95, of 3292 Orchard, died Thursday, Dec. 1, 1983, at his home of causes incident to age.

He was born Sept. 5, 1888, in Junction, Utah, a son of James Harvey Jr. and Rose Ellen Jackson Langford.

On Sept. 24, 1914, he married Zina Charlotte Chlarson in Tucson, Ariz. The marriage was solemnized in the Salt Lake LDS Temple in October of 1916. She died May 30, 1966.



He was a high priest in the Mount Ogden Stake 27th LDS Ward. He and his wife served a mission in the Weber Stake. He was a home teacher. He served as assistant high priest group leader and was an active temple worker.

He had lived in Colonia Oaxaca, Sonora, Mexico, from 1900 to 1912. The family moved to Tucson, Ariz., in 1912 and later moved to Hurley, N.M. In 1920 the family moved to Ogden.

He had worked for Saunders Construction Co. He owned and operated the Langford Plumbing and Heating Co. in Ogden from 1924 until retiring in 1955.

Surviving are three sons, Ernest F. Langford Jr. and James H. Langford, both of Ogden; Heber O. Langford, Layton; four daughters, Mrs. Irving W. (Irma) Wilcox, Holladay, Utah; Mrs. Iona Lemmons, Anchorage, Alaska; Mrs. Thomas W. (Iola) Spencer, Brownwood, Texas; Mrs. H. Tracy (Ida Rose) Hall, Provo; 27 grandchildren and 89 great-grandchildren.

Also surviving are two brothers, Angus LeRoy Langford, Magna, Utah, and Horace Fountain Langford, Overton, Nev.; three sisters, Mrs. Alden (Rose Ella) Snell, Orem, Utah; Mrs. Phillip (Vera) Snell, Bountiful; Mrs. William S. (Pearl Victoria) Winegar, Salt Lake City.

He was preceded in death by two grandsons.
