Thrusts in the zone of dislocation

- a. The Assynt (Glencoul) thrust on the south side of Loch Glencoul. Phyllonitized Lewisian gneiss rests on deformed Cambrian dolomite.
- b. Gorm Loch Mor and Ben More Assynt from the north, showing the outcrop of the Ben More thrust west of Gorm Loch Mor. Note the folding in the Cambrian quartzites (about north-trending axes) above the thrust.
