Gentlemen:

Thank you for your letter of July 16th in which you inquire into a Pressboard similar to a sample you enclosed with your letter but of about twice the thickness.

The sample you enclosed with your letter appears to be about .0125 - .013 thickness so we enclose samples of our Pressboard in .025 thickness which would be approximately twice the thickness of your sample. However, we believe that the sample you sent to us is what is known as Genuine Pressboard whereas ours is what is known as Imitation Pressboard, the main difference being that the Genuine Pressboard is a more dense sheet of paper.

If ours should prove of interest to you, however, we would suggest that further information could be obtained from the Salt Lake City branch of the Zellerbach Paper Company who would be agents for our papers. In fact, they may also be able to give you information about Genuine Pressboard which they could obtain from some other mill since they are a paper merchant who have access to products of many mills.
