His new products -- which are still current -ranged from extruded-and-hot-pressed transparent nuclearradiation dosimeters to eight-inch diameter opticallytransparent domes and discs from inorganic materials at, say, seven hundred degrees C and one hundred thousand pounds per square inch -- high, but modest in your field.
