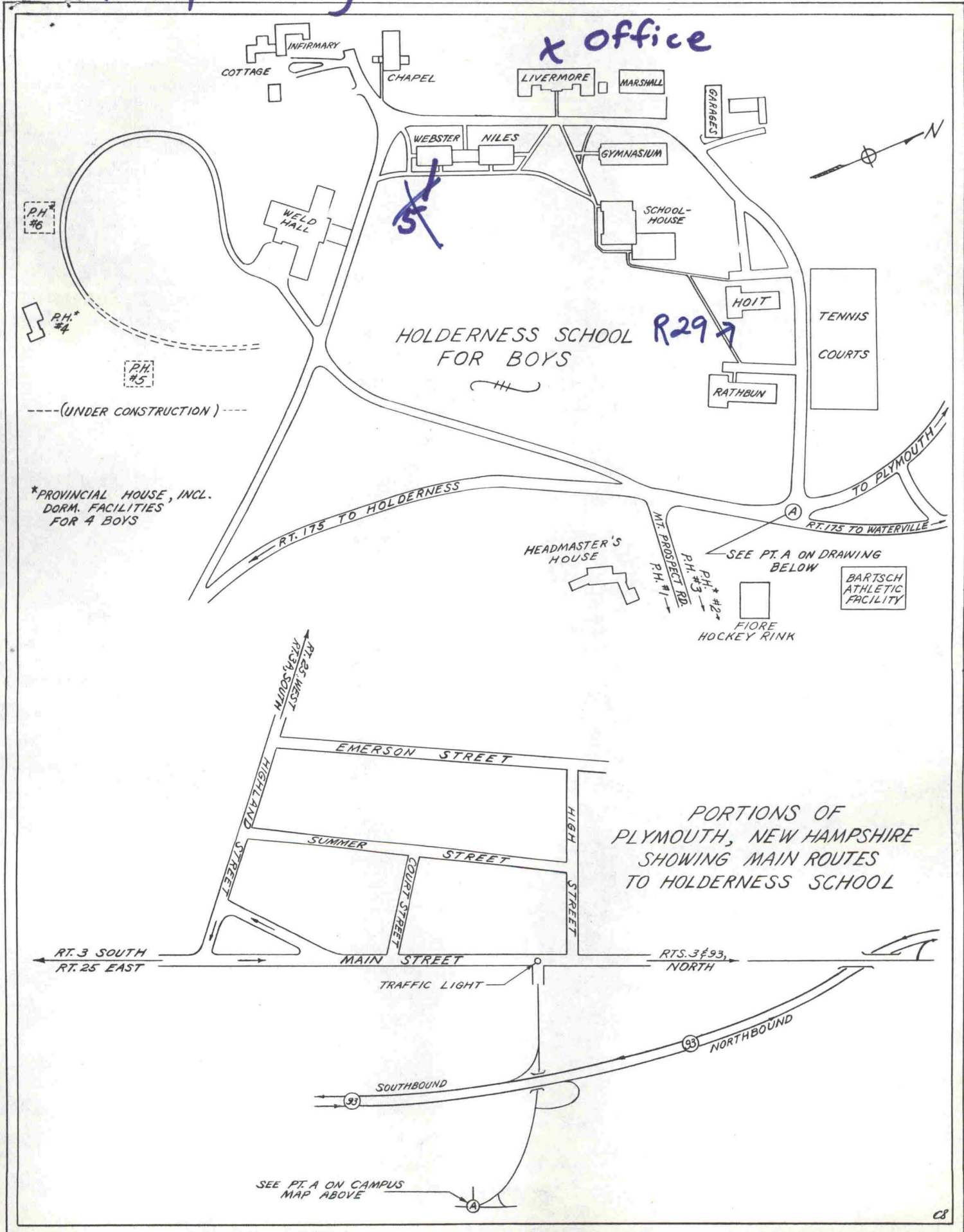

REGISTRATION

Please complete and return the enclosed registration card with the required deposit of \$30. This deposit will be credited against the Conference fixed fee if you attend the Conference. A registration card without the deposit will not be accepted. This deposit is not required of scientists from foreign countries.

Under "Special Requirements" please state whether you desire a single room, double room, or to share a room with a particular individual. Any other requirements, such as a physical handicap requiring the elimination of steps, should be stated.

The Board of Trustees of the Conference has established a fixed fee of \$130 for resident conferees at each Conference. Individuals not in residence at the Conference because of special requirements must pay a registration fee of \$65 instead of the resident fee of \$50.

GUESTS

A registration card and a deposit of \$30 is required for each guest. This deposit will be refunded if cancellation is received two weeks prior to the Conference.

CANCELLATION

The deposit will be forfeited if an approved application is cancelled. This deposit is not transferable to another Conference or conferee.

CONFERENCE MEETINGS

The meetings will be held daily at 9:00 a.m. and 7:30 p.m. (except Friday, when no evening session will be held). The Conference will close at noon on Friday.

BADGES

It is necessary to register at the Conference office and obtain your badge when you arrive. It is equally important when you leave to return your badge and notify the Conference office.
