I am going to hold a mtg. Thursday with Gary & his people to work out & study production info from last year and figure out how to do better next year.

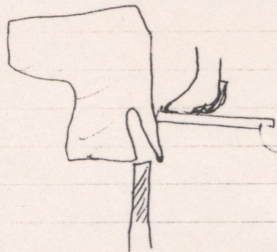
I spent some time working out a schedule on the 1000 B press. The church apparently found the letter take to Prof. Arthur by Master Harris.

We made our goal of 150 batches today. Looks like we will get 160 batches through with the press & the lab. We decided we need more screens & rotary machines. We have so much brass and coming through we need screening capacity to keep up.

Tom & Chris & I went over layout and approved Chris to go ahead with detailed design. I ask Chris to include on layout dimensions & spaces so that we could use layout for analysis & assembly etc. We are going to burnish moly into all mating surfaces with a copper brush. This will help prevent galling between like metals.

I spent the afternoon working on details for assembly fixtures. I also had Dave Gotsch start on re-modelling lunch room into assembly work area.
